

The American Society of Mechanical Engineers' (ASME) Elevator and Escalator Committee finalized the A17.1-2000 edition of the Safety Code for Elevators and Escalators on October 16, 2000.

Issued on March 23, 2001 – as both ASME A17.1-2000 and CSA B44-00 – it became available for adoption by jurisdictions across the US and Canada on March 23, 2002.

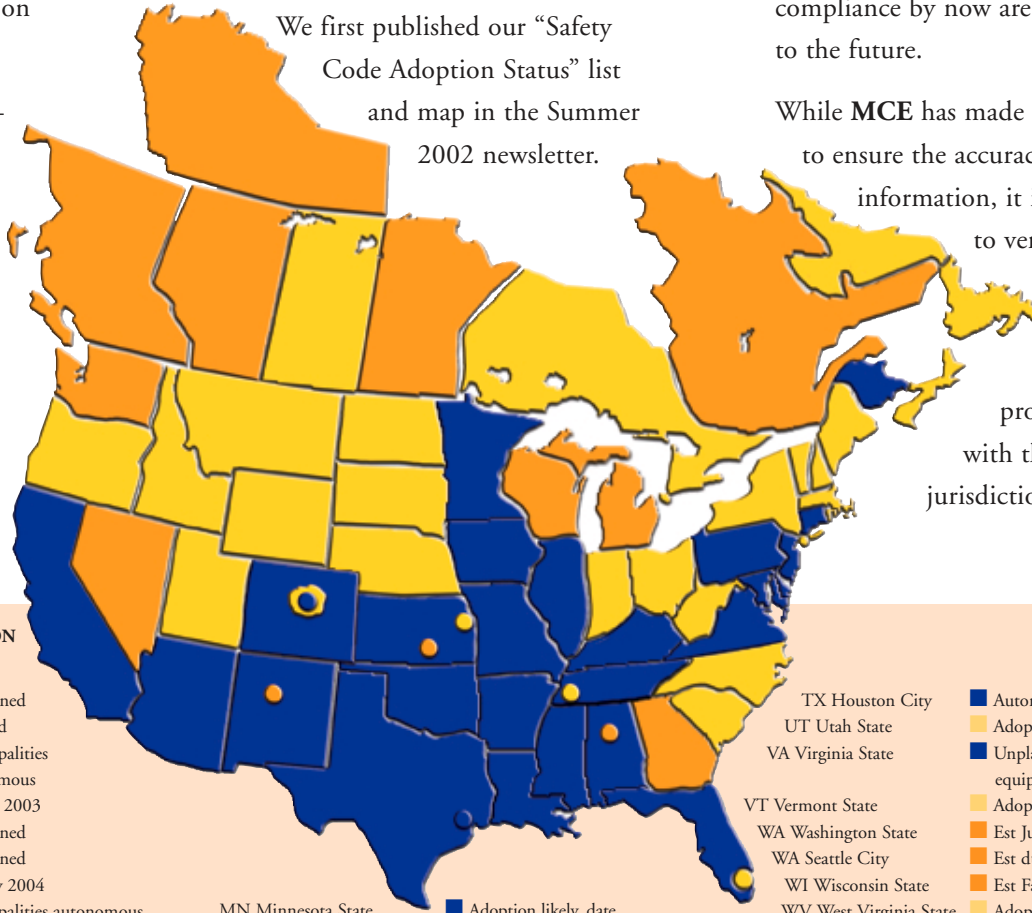
Many states and provinces had legislation in place to automatically adopt this latest code version.

Texas was thought to be an automatic adopter but later rescinded, effectively reverting to the A17.1-1993 edition, subject to pending future legislation.

We first published our "Safety Code Adoption Status" list and map in the Summer 2002 newsletter.

Almost a year later, it is interesting to note that the wheels of adoption turn slowly – many jurisdictions that anticipated requiring A17.1-2000 compliance by now are still looking to the future.

While MCE has made every effort to ensure the accuracy of this information, it is always best to verify which code will apply to your particular project. Check with the local jurisdictional authority.
